## Photography

I consent to club staff and other club parents taking photos and video material of my child on the understanding that this is for personal or club promotion and training purposes, that the images will not be reproduced or forwarded by electronic means without my permission and that any club use will NOT attach names to images without my written permission. I agree that I will in turn not reproduce or forward electronic or other forms of images of club activities without written permission.

## Club changing policy

Occasionally there may be circumstances where young players may find themselves changing clothes in the presence of people aged 18 or over. SRRUFC requests that, in this situation, it is the parent/guardian responsibility to safeguard their child and supervise them if necessary.

## Discipline

I consent to the coach, team manager or club official to discipline my child. (This will only include verbal admonishment and any suspension from playing or privileges as necessary). Any infringement of rules will be explained to the child fully. Any serious breach of conduct will be notified to parents as soon as possible and parents will be fully involved in how this is dealt with) I authorise the club safeguarding officers and/or coach to act in any official capacity as necessary in my absence.

## Medical

I consent for the coach, team manager, club first aider, club official, tour organiser to authorise medical treatment as may be necessary in my absence, including admission to hospital and such treatment the medical staff advise. (Your child will not be sent home, you will be contacted). By returning this completed form, I agree to my son/daughter in my care, taking part in the activities of the club.

## Head injuries

I agree if my child has had a head injury or bang on the head and a first aider has advised they are to be seen in hospital then I will take them. Please follow the Head case information given to all.

## Code of Conduct - Parents and Guardians

Parents / Carers are responsible for their child at all times during matches and training sessions. Coaches, managers and volunteer helpers cannot take legal responsibility for a child if the parent /carer is to leave. The parent can appoint another parent as the responsible person, but the parent must notify the coach or manager if they leave.

By signing and accepting the code of conduct you are also accepting responsibility for all family members you invite to the club and that they will observe the code of conduct.

### **Parents / Guardians should:**

- Encourage their child to play by the rules of the game and ensure club rules are followed.
- Encourage their child attends regularly.
- Encourage players to improve their skills by practice.
- Encourage their child to listen to the coach.
- Remember their child is playing for their own enjoyment, not that of the parent.
- Set a good example by applauding good play by both teams.
- Teach their child that winning isn't everything
- Respect the referee and coach and accept, without question, all refereeing decisions. Any issues must be directed through the team manager.
- Refrain from using foul language or inappropriate gestures at any player for making a mistake.
- NEVER enter the playing area (without the specific authorisation of the referee) in response to the actions of others, whatever the provocation. Stay off the pitch & behind the barrier if one is present.
- Take an active part in the clubs activities.

Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring that their child has the necessary kit for training and matches, including mouth guards and correct studs. If there is any reason why a child should not wear a mouth guard, or if a parent/guardian does not wish a child to wear a mouth guard, the parent/guardian must inform the child's team coach/manager in writing.

Parents/guardians are responsible for informing their child's coach or/and manager of any illness or injury, however minor that may affect their child's ability to train or play in a match.

Parents/guardians must keep the coach/manager informed of attendance for training and matches.

**I agree as a parent/guardian of a child with SRRUFC, I have read and agree to abide by the parents code of conduct at all times. Failure to do so could result in expulsion from the Club.**

# Safeguarding

Stanley Rodillian RUFC recognises that everyone has a responsibility for protecting children under the age of 18. If any member / parent / guardian or spectator, has concerns about any child associated with the club, they should discuss them with the club's Safeguarding Officer.

Stanley Rodillians RUFC safeguarding policy is in place and includes all the core elements of the RFU recommended policies and procedures for the welfare of young people in the sport of Rugby Union.

## **Stanley Rodillians RUFC has:**

- Appointed club safeguarding officer(s) who acts as the first point of contact for concerns about the welfare of young people.
- Ensures that all officers and committee members are aware of their responsibilities in this area and that the club respond to any indication of poor practice or abuse in line with the RFU policy.
- Implement a policy of best practice for all adults working with young people as set out by the various codes of conduct.
- Ensure that all relevant members who have regular supervisory contact with children or a management responsibility for those working with young people undertake an Enhanced Disclosure and Barring service (DBS) check
- Actively supports and encourages coaches and other volunteers to undertake training to support them in their work with young children.

All volunteers are expected to follow the guidelines as set out by the clubs safeguarding policy and the Rugby Football Union's "RFU Safeguarding policy and procedure".

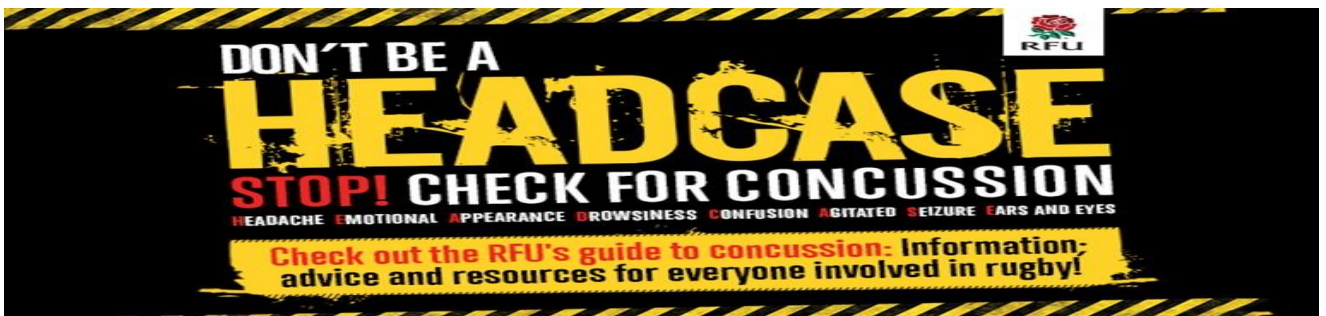
